

SELECTIVE AWARDS and MASTER'S DEGREE PROGRAMS – Humanities and Social Sciences –

FULBRIGHT US STUDENT PROGRAM for 2021-2022

This selective list includes awards that meet some or all of the following criteria:

- **Graduate degrees that are taught in English**
- **Full graduate program is funded, for both 1-Year and 2-Year Master's Degrees**
- **Programs were undersubscribed (under applied for) in recent application cycles**

AUSTRALIA

Anne Wexler Master's Award in Public Policy (2-year award)

The aim of the Fulbright Anne Wexler scholarships in Public Policy are to grow Australian-American educational linkages by building a network of public policy experts and to encourage ongoing policy exchange between both countries. The award will enable U.S. students with strong academic credentials and leadership potential to undertake a master's degree in Australia in a key area of public policy.

Applications will be considered in the following fields: Agriculture, History, Ecology, Economics, Education, Energy, Environmental Studies, Law, Political Science, Public Administration, Public Health, Social Work, Transportation, and Urban Development & Planning.

Students will undertake full time master's degree study and will commence their grants in February 2022.

(Last year, 27 applications were received and 1 award was granted.)

Western Sydney University, Master's Award

One award will be granted in one of the following fields: **Creative and Performing Arts, Environmental Studies, Social Justice or Public Health**

The Fulbright Postgraduate Scholarship funded by Western Sydney University will attract a diverse range of exceptional applicants who have recently completed their undergraduate studies and who are seeking to undertake 8-10 months of study/ research in an area of focus for the University.

Candidates must commence their grants at the start of the university year in January or February 2022 with the specific start date agreed upon by both grantee and host institution. (July 2021 in some cases - by approval only).

(Last year, 15 applications were received and 1 award was granted.)

FINLAND

Tampere University Graduate (Master's) Awards, (Two-Year Program)

Up to 2 awards are offered for students who wish to complete a master's degree in any field offered at the [Tampere University](#).

The tuition scholarship is granted also for the second year of master's studies provided that the grantee has been successful in his/her studies during the first year.

The award competition is open to U.S. students who hold minimum bachelor's degree. Academically talented graduating seniors may also apply before having the degree in hand. The grant is aimed for students who wish to complete a full master's degree at the Tampere University.

(Last year, 8 applications were received and 2 awards were granted.)

University of Turku Graduate (Master's) Awards

Up to 2 awards are offered to pursue study or research in any field at the Master's or Doctoral level at the [University of Turku](#).

The graduate award is aimed at those currently seeking admittance, or already admitted, to the University of Turku, to one of its graduate degree programs (MA or PhD).

(Last year, 4 applications were received and 2 awards were granted.)

University of Helsinki Master's Award

One award is offered to pursue an International Master's Degree Program in any field at the [University of Helsinki](#).

The grant is aimed at students who wish to complete a master's degree at the University of Helsinki.

(Last year, 17 applications were received and 2 awards were granted.)

NEW THIS YEAR! University of Jyväskylä Master's Award

One award is offered for U.S. students who wish to complete a master's degree in any field at the [University of Jyväskylä](#).

The tuition scholarship is granted also for the second year of master's studies provided that the grantee has been successful in his/her studies during the first year.

IRELAND

Dublin City University Master's Award

One award is offered to pursue a Master's Program that builds on previous academic work or assists in future academic study at Dublin City University (DCU). Students apply to one of 5 faculties:

Humanities and Social Sciences
Engineering and Computing
Business School
Science and Health
Education

(Last year, 17 applications were received and 1 award was granted.)

THE NETHERLANDS

Erasmus U. Rotterdam, Suzana Rodrigues Award, Master's Degree

The enterprising academics and students endeavor to solve global social challenges in the fields of wealth, health, governance and culture.

Candidates should be very well qualified and strongly motivated for one of the graduate courses in any field at Erasmus University Rotterdam. Only master programs with a Croho code starting with "6" are eligible.

(Last year, 12 applications were received and 1 award was granted.)

Maastricht U. Master's Awards

Maastricht University uses Problem-Based Learning, an innovative teaching method that focuses on small groups, active participation, and informal contacts between students and the academic staff. This approach to teaching, together with the international student population, gives students significant opportunities to acquire knowledge and experience from a range of different perspectives.

Applications will be considered from well-qualified candidates in all fields for which graduate programs are offered by Maastricht University.

(Last year, 25 applications were received and 2 awards were granted.)

Radboud University Research Master's Award

Applications are welcome from individuals with an excellent academic record, who meet the requirements for one of the eligible (Research) Master's programs, are interested in engaging in extracurricular activities and who demonstrate a strong motivation to study at Radboud University Nijmegen.

(Last year, 3 applications were received and 1 award was granted.)

Vrije U. Amsterdam Awards

Four awards are offered in any field of graduate study to complete a taught Master's degree.

(Last year, 24 applications were received and 4 awards were granted.)

S. KOREA

Korean Studies Master's Degree Awards (2-year award)

Grant recipients will receive support for the duration of a two-year master's degree program upon successful admission to a Korean university. Applicants **MUST** pursue a graduate **degree in Korean Studies**.

Only candidates who demonstrate a specific intent to pursue Korean Studies as a career and who focus their program primarily on Korea will be considered.

Grant support is for two academic years. However, renewal for the second year is dependent upon the grantee achieving academic success in the first year.

The Korean academic year typically begins in March. Thus, most grantees are anticipated to begin their grants in the February following grant award notification. However, should the proposed university program offer a fall start date, grantees may be able to start during the fall following grant award notification.

(Last year, 8 applications were received and 2 awards were granted.)

SPAIN

Universidad de Salamanca Global and International Studies Master's Award

Classes will be taught in English.

The program includes diverse but complementary components.

- 1) Academic offerings: three cutting-edge Master's programs with international faculty members, including several prestigious American professors and practitioners, together with their Spanish and other European colleagues.
- 2) An ambitious internship program that provides professional opportunities both in Europe and Washington, D.C.
- 3) A think-tank that will not only generate innovative ideas, but also forge connections with real-world projects beyond the walls of the university. Several former foreign ministers and ambassadors, form part of the team.

The MGIS program is open to graduate students with diverse academic backgrounds. The screening committee values previous experience in the fields of Law, Political Science, History, Sociology, Security, International Organizations and Global Economy.

(Last year, 29 applications were received and 1 award was granted.)

IE School of Global and Public Affairs Master's Award

IE School of Global and Public Affairs is committed to creating global leaders who are ready to take on the roles of tomorrow's world actors and become catalysts for positive change.

One Award for either of the following full-time masters at IE School of Global and Public Affairs:

- Master in International Relations

This program is designed for recent graduates and early to mid-career professionals with backgrounds in Business, International Relations, Economics, Political Sciences, Law or Social Sciences. Other backgrounds such as Engineering, Finance and Humanities are also welcome.

- Master in International Development

This program is designed for recent graduates and young professionals with backgrounds in International Relations, Economics, Political Sciences, Law or Social Sciences. Other backgrounds such as Engineering, Business, and Humanities are also welcome.

(Last year, 28 applications were received and 1 award was granted.)

TAIWAN

Debate Coach/Trainer Awards

Award Profile:

- Help coach and build up debate programs at Taiwan's top schools

- Build up a local debate circuit and run and judge local tournaments
- Train interested Fulbrighters, including English Teaching Assistants, students, and scholars, how to coach debate --this will provide an avenue for these Fulbrighter's community service.
- Traveling with teams to tournaments
- Generate and research arguments within a group setting
- Work with other teachers to further develop the debate program
- Organize a debate camp in the summer for interested students

Applicants' qualifications should include:

- Experienced debate coaching/teaching in a high performing school preferred, but not required
- 3+ years' experience in nationally competitive debate
- Ability to teach Public Forum and Policy debate
- Cross-Cultural experience is an asset
- Strong interpersonal skills

Applications are welcome in all fields of study, especially in political science, law, international relations, and language arts (including communications, rhetoric, and argumentation). Candidate must be willing and able to work with a high degree of independence.

(Last year, 22 applications were received and 2 awards were granted.)

National Chengchi U. Master's in International Studies, Asia-Pacific Studies, or International Communication Studies (2-year award)

Awards are available to pursue a full-time master's degree programs in International Studies (IMPIS), Asia-Pacific Studies (IMAS), or International Communications Studies (IMICS) at National Chengchi University (NCCU). The program is taught in English.

The grant is initially awarded for 12 months, and renewal for the second year is dependent upon the grantee's academic success with a minimum GPA of 3.0 (B) on a 4.0 scale.

(Last year, 35 applications were received and 3 awards were granted.)

National Taiwan U. Master's in Agricultural Economics or Global Health (2-year award)

Awards are available to pursue a full-time master's degree programs in Agricultural Economics or Global Health at National Taiwan University (NTU). The program is taught in English.

The grant is initially awarded for 12 months, and renewal for the second year is dependent upon the grantees' academic success with a minimum GPA of 3.0 (B) on a 4.0 scale.

(Last year, 30 applications were received and 3 awards were granted.)
